Welcome to the Blue Room! We hope you and the children have had a pleasant summer holiday and the children are ready to learn during our busy, but exciting, new term! Here's a taster of what we will be doing:

Science

Living things and habitats – we will be exploring different habitats and meeting the inhabitants of different ecosystems around the world.

Plants – through experiments and plenty of hands-on activities, we will discover what plants need to grow, and how we can best help them thrive.

Geography

Recycling – this topic includes how we can best look after our local environment, and focuses on the benefits of recycling. We then take a broader perspective and examine the impact of waste and recycling globally.



History

The Romans – we will read tales of Roman Gods and Goddesses, find out about the Roman Army and learn about the invasion of Britain. We will also hold an exciting Roman Day where the children will take part in a range of Roman-inspired activities and can dress up as Romans themselves!

Art

This will link in with our topic and science work, and includes creating aged Roman portraits, mosaics and observational drawings for living things and their habitats.
