**Week 3** (week commencing 28.9.20): (words spelt with y)  
gym, myth, mystery, cycle, rhyme, crystal, style, type, symbol, Egypt

**Week 4** (week commencing 5.10.20): (irregular past tense verbs)  
taught, thought, said, ate, drank, brought, caught, broke, knew, spoke

**Week 5** (week commencing 12.10.20): (letter pattern 'ou')
